This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by:

Based on a review of laboratory personnel records, lack of documentation, and interviews with laboratory staff, it was determined the laboratory failed document that one of six testing personnel (#3 as listed on the CMS 209 form) met educational requirements to perform moderate complexity testing. Survey findings follow: A) The laboratory failed to have documentation of education for one of six testing personnel (#3 as listed on the CMS 209 form) that would qualify testing personnel to perform moderate complexity testing. C) In the interview, at 2:45pm on 3/24/26 , the technical consultant confirmed the lack of documentation of highest level of education, which would qualify employee to perform moderate complexity testing.
