<b>D6053</b>	<p>TECHNICAL CONSULTANT RESPONSIBILITIES CFR(s): 493.1413(b)(9)</p> <p>The technical consultant is responsible for evaluating and documenting the performance of individuals responsible for moderate complexity testing at least semiannually during the first year the individual tests patient specimens.</p> <p>This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Through review of personnel competency records for three testing personnel listed on the CMS 209 form, authorizations to perform tests, and interview, it was determined that the laboratory did not assess the competency of one of three testing personnel semi-annually during the first year of employment. Findings follow: A) Review of personnel records of testing personnel (number 8 on the CMS 209 form) indicated that the employee was hired in November 2021 and authorized by the laboratory director to perform moderately complex testing without direct supervision. B) Upon review of personnel records of testing personnel (number 2 on the CMS 209 form) Initial competency evaluation were dated as performed on July 5, 2023, and no further document competencies performed semi-annually during the first year of employment which should have occurred January of 2024 for this personnel. C) In an interview on 3/15/2024 at 1:10 p.m., the testing personnel (number 1 on the CMS 209 form) verified that competency evaluations were not performed semi-annually during the first year of employment for the testing personnel (number 3 on the CMS 209 form).</p>
