D0000	An announced CLIA recertification survey was conducted at Coastal Skin Surgery and Dermatology on 07/23/2026. The laboratory was surveyed under 42 CFR Part 493 CLIA requirements. Standard deficiencies cited are as follows:
D6005	LABORATORY DIRECTOR RESPONSIBILITIES CFR(s): 493.1407(c) (c) The laboratory director must: (c)(1) Be onsite at least once every 6 months, with at least 4 months between the minimum two on-site visits. Laboratory directors may elect to be on-site more frequently and must continue to be accessible to the laboratory to provide telephone or electronic consultation as needed; and (c)(2) Provide documentation of these visits, including evidence of performing activities that are part of the laboratory director responsibilities. This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and Laboratory Director (LD) interview, LD failed to establish a policy to be onsite at least once every six months, with at least 4 months between the minimum two on-site visits and documenting the onsite visits during the year 2025 until 07/22/2026. Findings included: 1:) Review of the procedure manual signed by the LD on 01/30/2026 revealed that it did not have policy to specify when the LD must be onsite and document the bi-annual visits. 2:) During interview on 07/23/2026 at approximately 2:24 PM, the LD confirmed there was no policy to monitor the LD visits to the laboratory. LD also stated he is in laboratory daily to read and sign off quality control slides, as well as read patient slides, but specified there is no specific documentation or policy for bi-annual visits.
