<b>D6102</b>	<p><b>LABORATORY DIRECTOR RESPONSIBILITIES</b> CFR(s): 493.1445(e)(12)</p> <p>The laboratory director must ensure that prior to testing patients' specimens, all personnel have the appropriate education and experience, receive the appropriate training for the type and complexity of the services offered, and have demonstrated that they can perform all testing operations reliably to provide and report accurate results.</p> <p>This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and interview with the Consultant, the laboratory director failed to document training for one (B) of two testing personnel. Findings included: A review of CMS Form 209 titled Laboratory Personnel Report signed by the laboratory director on 12/10/18 revealed Testing Person B performed high complexity histology testing. A review of Testing Person B's personnel file revealed no training records. Interview on 12/10/2018 at 11:00 AM with the Consultant, confirmed there were no training records for Testing Person B for histology testing.</p>
