Findings: 1. Based on review of the testing personnel records, TP #1, #2, #6, #7 and TP #8 (CMS form 209) did not have a copy of their high school diploma or equivalent in their personnel record. 2. Interview with the facility manager, and staff #10, on August 14, 2018 at approximately 2:30 pm, in the facility manager's office, confirmed that there was not a copy of their high school diploma or equivalent in their personnel record.</p>
