This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by:

Based on review of laboratory personnel records and confirmed by laboratory personnel identifier #1 (refer to the Laboratory Personnel Report) at approximately 8:45 am on 02/18/22, the laboratory failed to have documentation to qualify six out of 21 testing personnel (identifiers #2 - #7) who perform moderate complexity testing. The findings include: 1. Testing personnel identifiers #2 - #7 all began performing moderate complexity testing since the last survey performed on 1/21/2020. 2. At the time of the survey, the laboratory did not have diplomas and/or transcripts to qualify testing personnel identifiers #2 - #7 to perform moderate complexity testing.
