D5209	<p>PERSONNEL COMPETENCY ASSESSMENT POLICIES CFR(s): 493.1235</p> <p>As specified in the personnel requirements in subpart M, the laboratory must establish and follow written policies and procedures to assess employee and, if applicable, consultant competency.</p> <p>This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and interview with the Technical Consultant (TC), the laboratory failed to follow the written procedure to assess the competency of all laboratory personnel. Findings include: 1. Review of the laboratory's 2022 employee competency records on 8/24/2023 revealed the Laboratory Director (LD) did not document a competency for the Technical Consultant (TC) for his/her CLIA federal regulatory responsibilities. 2. Review on 8/24/2023 of the laboratory's 'Competency Assessment' Policy revealed: "..competency assessments required of the Technical Supervisor (TS) and Technical Consultant (TC) roles that are done by the Lab Director (LD). If the TS or TC also perform testing in the lab, the technical competency assessment must also be done." 3. Staff interview with the TC on 8/24/2023 at 9:00am confirmed the above findings. 4. The laboratory performs 51,500 tests annually in the specialty of Hematology.</p>

Based on record review and staff interview, the Technical Consultant (TC) failed to evaluate the competency of all testing personnel (TP) to perform moderate complexity testing in the specialty of Hematology. Findings include: 1. Record review on 8/24/2023 of the laboratory's 2022 competency documentation for 2 or 2 TP, revealed the TC had not completed the competencies and peer review to be documented. 2. Record review on 8/24/2023 of the laboratory's competency assessment policy revealed: "The assessments are the responsibility of the technical personnel to complete." 3. Staff interview with the TC on 8/24/2023 at 9:00am confirmed the above findings. 4. The laboratory performs 51'500 tests annually in the specialty of Hematology.
