D5401	PROCEDURE MANUAL CFR(s): 493.1251(a) (a) A written procedures manual for all tests, assays, and examinations performed by the laboratory must be available to, and followed by, laboratory personnel. Textbooks may supplement but not replace the laboratory's written procedures for testing or examining specimens. This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Based on surveyor Procedure Manual (PM) and interview with the Office Manager (OM), the laboratory failed to follow the procedure "QC Stain by Pathologist"" from September 2025 to 8/12/26. The findings include: 1. The PM stated "4) After reviewing the H&E stain the pathologist will initial the Pathology Solutions Slide stain log sent with the surgical specimen slides. The pathologist will indicate if the stain was good on the slide stain log" 2. The PM stated "7) If immuno-hisochemiastry stains are done then the pathologist will review the positive and negative controls and if they are both adequate then the pathologist will mark acceptable on the slide stain log. If either or both of the controls are not acceptable then the pathologist will indicate unacceptable on the slide stain log and indicate the reason." 3. There was no documented evidence that above mentioned procedure were performed. 4. The laboratory no longer uses Pathology Solutions for the Technical component of histopathology testing. 5. The OM confirmed on 8/12/26 at 11:15 pm the laboratory did not follow the above mentioned procedures.
