D6004	LABORATORY DIRECTOR RESPONSIBILITIES CFR(s): 493.1407(a)(b) The laboratory director is responsible for the overall operation and administration of the laboratory, including the employment of personnel who are competent to perform test procedures, and record and report test results promptly, accurate, and proficiently and for assuring compliance with the applicable regulations. (a) The laboratory director, if qualified, may perform the duties of the technical consultant, clinical consultant, and testing personnel, or delegate these responsibilities to personnel meeting the qualifications of 493.1409, 493.1415, and 493.1421, respectively. (b) If the laboratory director reapportions performance of his or her responsibilities, he or she remains responsible for ensuring that all duties are properly performed. This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Based on review of the Automated Survey Processing Environment (ASPEN) Web 116 database, review of the Centers for Medicare and the Medicaid Services Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) Application for Certification (Form CMS-116), review of the Disclosure of Ownership and Control Interest Statement - TN (CHOW), lack of documentation, and staff interviews, the laboratory director failed to maintain compliance with the notification requirements at 493.51, when the state agency was not notified within 30 days of the change in ownership in December of 2025. The findings included: 1. Review of the ASPEN Web 116 database revealed the laboratory's name was listed as Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine of East Memphis. 2. Review of the survey Form CMS-116 revealed that the laboratory name was listed as ZP Central, PLLC, DBA Zarminali Pediatrics, and the Form CHOW revealed the laboratory had changed ownership to ZP Central, PLLC. 3. A search of ASPEN Web-116 database revealed that there was no documentation that the laboratory notified the state agency of the change of ownership. 4. The Technical Consultant stated during an interview on July 14, 2026, at 11:30 a.m. that the

laboratory changed ownership in the winter of 2025. 5. The Technical Consultant confirmed the survey findings during a phone interview on July 15, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.
