D0000	An announced focused survey for compliance with SARS-CoV-2 test result reporting requirements was conducted remotely at the Seniors Crossing on July 1, 2021 by the Virginia Department of Health's Office of Licensure and Certification. The laboratory was surveyed under 42 CFR part 493 CLIA Requirements. Initial interview and CMS Letter to Director for the Focused Survey sent on June 17, 2021. Specific deficiencies cited are as follows: The laboratory was not in compliance with the following 42 CFR part 493 CLIA Regulations: D1002 - 42 C.F.R. 493-41 Condition: Reporting of SARS-CoV-2 Test Reports.
